## Technical Specifications / Scope of Service Requirements:

Scope of Lecture	The Expert Practitioner must deliver a lecture and demonstration (in English) that includes:
	<ul> <li>topics on family safety, basic knowledge and practical tips on self-defense, and analysis of situations where crimes and acts of violence may be committed;</li> <li>mental exercises that will help participants create a mindset on how to recognize threats and how to effectively react and respond to them;</li> <li>self-defense tactics and approaches depending on the various situations and hazards the participants may face and are customized based on the capabilities of male and female participants;</li> <li>techniques on how to use the participant's body parts to minimize injury that may be inflicted on them;</li> <li>identification of vital parts of the human body and use it to control the aggressiveness of the attacker; and</li> <li>identification of objects that participants, particularly female, to carry as effective self-defense tools.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>have previous experience in delivering a similar lecture and/or demonstration in an international community setting; and</li> <li>submit a Company Profile and/or Curriculum Vitae.</li> </ul>
